Educators have Working with Children Checks, hold First Aid, CPR, Asthma Emergency Management, Anaphylaxis, Child Protection, Mandatory Reporting, and Infection Control Certificates.

Enrolling -

To enroll, please scan the QR code or visit our website and click on the

Enrolments page. Enrolments are completed online.

We use Xplor for all our administration, signing in/out, financial matters, messaging and notifications, health, and medical details, advising of absences and more.

Bookings -

Vacation Care bookings are made through the Xplor Home app.

Excursions/IncurSION -

All incursions/excursion are a set part of the program. By booking through the app for those days you are agreeing for your child/children to participate in the activity. This may include Kharisma Kids educators taking children off-site to another venue by bus, train or by walking as listed on the planner. Risk Assessments are completed by Kharisma Kids and available for parent to view at their request.

Cancellations -

Please book your days carefully as there are no cancellations or transfers for Vacation Care.

CCS-

We are an approved service; therefore, we deduct your ChildCare Subsidy entitlements from your fees.

What are children required to bring?

Children are expected to be dressed appropriately for the day's activities and the weather. We ask that children do not wear sleeveless tops, slip-on shoes or thongs.

Children should have a healthy morning tea and lunch brought from home every day. High risk foods such as rice, meats, yoghurt etc. must be stored in a cooler lunch box with an ice block all year round (*not just in Summer*). We provide an Afternoon snack each day.

A refillable drink bottle is recommended with water.

SunSmart approved hats must be worn every day

from 1st September to 30th April.

We do not allow any electronic devices e.g., iPads, tablet devices, mobile phones. Due to new

legislation we MUST NOT allow phones to be used at the service, except for Signing In/Out. Cameras or taking photos are strictly prohibited to be used at any time within the service or school property.

Children must be signed in and out by an authorised person for each session. Admin fees apply for staff having to sign any child in or out.

All parents must have the app installed using their own phone number and email address. Other Authorised persons must be assigned on the Xplor app and will use the Ipad to sign in and out.

If your child is absent for any reason, it is the parent's responsibility to notify of the absence via the Xplor app.
